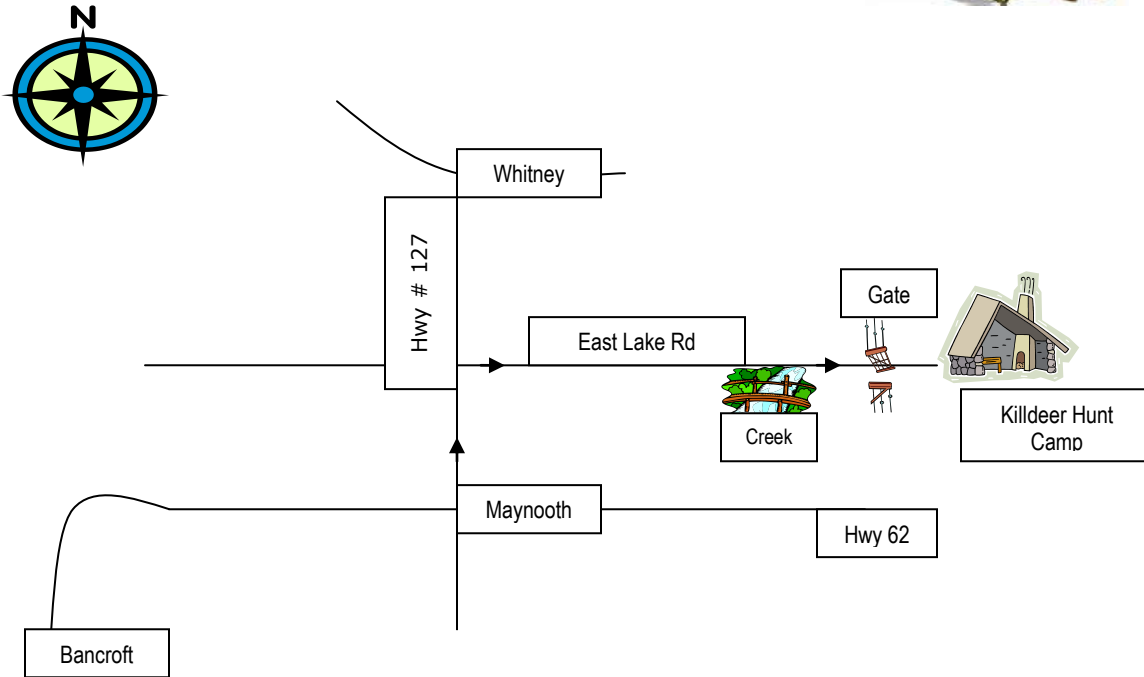
There will be a bon fire to enjoy, along with bon fire snacks.

Directions:

From the 4 corners in the village of Maynooth – take Hwy 127 north (toward Whitney) approximately 1 mile to East Lake Road. Turn right and stay on the main road. When you come to the end of the paved road continue on the dirt road. After crossing a creek, go up a hill, across a flat crooked section of road, through a gate and you have arrived - brown building with red roof. The camp is about 3 km from Hwy 127.
